

CULTURAL LEADERSHIP AGREEMENT CLASS 13

Cultural Leadership is an exciting, demanding, and essential program. There are many responsibilities and obligations connected to participation in Cultural Leadership. Please read the following agreement and discuss it with your parents/guardians to be sure you are ALL willing and able to make the necessary commitment to Cultural Leadership. If you plan to commit to this program, please read and initial each statement on the line provided.

I understand that:

- _____ Attendance is expected at ALL Cultural Leadership programs, retreats and the entire Transformational Journey. There are four reasons that Cultural Leadership allows a student to miss a program: illness, death in the family, something that affects your future, and a family event that will never happen again such as a sibling graduation. Requests for approved absences should be submitted to the Program Director as soon as the conflict is known and no later than three weeks in advance.
- _____ I will occasionally be assigned a short homework assignment that complements the program curriculum and I agree to complete that homework on time.
- _____ The use of all cell phones, tablets, and any personal computer device is PROHIBITED during all program activities. I agree to pay Cultural Leadership \$1, on the spot, if my cell phone or device is in use or rings/vibrates or if I text message during a program or speaker.
- _____ Falling asleep during a speaker at any point during Cultural Leadership will result in a \$5 fine that I agree to pay.

I will:

- _____ Show respect for everyone involved at all times.
- _____ Be present and punctual, and I will participate at all events and programs per the attendance requirements listed above.
- _____ Go out of my comfort zone to make change in my family/school/house of worship during my year in Cultural Leadership. I will write a brief paragraph describing my “out of comfort zone” experience each month before each program.
- _____ I will take note of at LEAST one current event that relates to a given program or the general mission of Cultural Leadership and have ready to share at any given month’s program.
- _____ Maintain a reliable way for Cultural Leadership to contact me (email, cell phone calls/text messages, home phone) and I will respond to any messages within 24 hours.
- _____ Inform Cultural Leadership of any change in my contact information, including address, all phone numbers, and email addresses, as soon as the change occurs.
- _____ Volunteer a minimum of 10 hours in the Cultural Leadership office during the year, in addition, I will attend special events and fundraisers as much as possible.
- _____ Write thank you notes (to donors, speakers, the media, etc.) and articles/blogs for the Cultural Leadership newsletter/website as requested.
- _____ Keep a journal and complete evaluations of programs as requested.
- _____ Write letters to at least 10 people (family, friends, teachers, clergy, neighbors, etc.) asking for a donation to Cultural Leadership at a scheduled time before the trip.
- _____ Participate in a phone-a-thon to maintain relationships with alumni and ask for donations to Cultural Leadership.
- _____ Give at least two speeches about Cultural Leadership prior to graduation.
- _____ Participate in the School Swap to learn about the inequities in our educational system and see what part I can play in increasing academic achievement in underperforming schools.
- _____ Facilitate/lead at least one Courageous Conversation throughout the community after the “Learning How to Facilitate Discussions” overnight retreat.
- _____ Plan and implement a social justice action project before graduation. Take a leadership role within the project and report on progress throughout the year.

I realize that:

_____ I may be uncomfortable at times, but agree to “lean into the discomfort” in order to better myself and better my community.

_____ It is an honor and a privilege to be chosen as a participant of Cultural Leadership and I commit to the above during the 2016-2017 program year. I am excited about Cultural Leadership, and am open to having an incredible, life-changing experience that will teach me to be an activist for social justice.

I will **NOT**:

_____ Possess, consume, or distribute alcoholic beverages;

_____ Possess, use, or distribute any illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia;

_____ Smoke, consume, or distribute tobacco products;

_____ Possess or use any weapon, firearm, or anything that may be construed as a weapon;

_____ Engage in ANY sexual behavior with my fellow participants, regardless of gender;

_____ Leave any program venue without permission from the Cultural Leadership staff.

_____ **I agree to abide by any additional rules**, pertinent to a specific event, that may be announced, and to accept the consequences of their violation, including possible expulsion from Cultural Leadership.

Violation of any of these rules will result in my dismissal from the program.

Parent Agreement

I understand that Cultural Leadership is for parents, too. I will make every effort to attend the parent meetings. I will provide food for at least three programs/retreats. I agree to make sure my student gets to Cultural Leadership programs on time and will be picked up when they are over. I will pay the \$2,500 tuition fee - \$100 due at the time my student is accepted, and the remainder due by September 1, 2016. (Note, payment plans and need-based scholarships are available on request.) I will also make a donation to Cultural Leadership after the trip. I further agree to give my credit card information in a sealed envelope to the Cultural Leadership staff before the trip and know that it will be opened only in the case of an emergency to purchase a return flight home if my student must be sent home from the trip, and I further agree to pay for any remaining plane tickets unused by my student.
