

ABOUT US

Cultural Leadership is a nonprofit youth educational and leadership development organization that exists to develop a generation of socially aware, culturally conscious youth leaders. We challenge local middle and high school students in the St. Louis region to learn more about social justice issues and how to solve them in their communities, workplaces, and schools.

Cultural Leadership's Mission is to create a more just and equitable community by educating middle and high school students to recognize and resolve issues of privilege and injustice through the lens of the African American and Jewish experience. Established in 2004, Cultural Leadership has now trained more than 320 young people to develop leadership skills, facilitate dialogues, build relationships, and create change in their circles of influence.

PROGRAMS

High School Program— Stand Up. Speak Out. Take Action.

Cultural Leadership's High School Program is a year-long, educational and leadership training program where students engage in over 460 programming hours. Each Cultural Leadership class is a racially and economically diverse group of 24-30 students from both public and private high schools throughout the St. Louis region.

Our award winning curriculum includes three overnight retreats, monthly meetings, and a three-week summer trip. Termed the "transformational journey," the trip covers historical sites in New York, Washington DC, Atlanta, and significant places in the South. Students also meet with national policymakers, thought leaders, and journalists who enrich their experience. Other highlights include our community-recognized School Swap, Holiday Swap, and Courageous Conversations.

Camp Cultural Leadership— Experience. Lead. Change.

Launched in 2014, Camp Cultural Leadership condenses the programming of our year-long high school program into a three-week summer camp for rising 7th, 8th, and 9th graders. The Camp introduces and reinforces social justice concepts and ties them to leadership skills in a way that challenges our participants to have "courageous conversations." As a capstone to their camp experience, the students take an overnight trip to Memphis, Tennessee or Chicago, IL to visit noteworthy civil rights museums and meet local change agents.

Social Justice, Diversity and Inclusion College Summer Internship Program

Alumni of Cultural Leadership's high school or middle school programs were placed in part-time and full-time summer internships with nonprofit organizations and corporations. Internships focused on issues and programs relating to social justice, or diversity and inclusion.
